

The FAN Charity – Privacy Notice for Facilitators

The FAN Charity will be what's known as the 'Controller' of the personal data you provide to us. We only collect basic personal data about you which does not include any special types of information or location-based information. This does however include name, address, email and telephone number.

Why we need your data

We need to know your basic personal data so that we can provide you with information about FAN and items that may be of interest to Fan Groups. In order to provide and oversee this service to you, we will not collect from you any personal data we do not need.

What we do with your data

All the personal data we process is handled by FAN Staff on a password protected computer and encrypted database. However, for the purposes of security and back up this information is also located on servers within the European Union. No 3rd parties have access to your personal data unless the law allows them to do so. Our lawful basis for processing your data is known as the Legitimate Interests basis. This means we establish a legitimate interest in processing your information as, without doing so, we cannot offer you information about FAN.

How long we keep your data

We will keep your basic personal data (name, address, contact details) as long as you remain a FAN facilitator after which time it will be destroyed.

If you no longer wish to receive information

If you have opted to receive information about FAN you can unsubscribe at any time by phoning the FAN Manager on 07880630553 or sending an email to: fanofficer@ymail.com. You can also simply reply to FAN e mails with the word 'STOP'.

What are your rights?

If at any point you believe the information we process on you is incorrect you can request to see this information and have it corrected or deleted. If you wish to raise a complaint on how we have handled your personal data, you can contact us to have the matter investigated.
